

Family Night Youth Football Scrimmage

South Field (Oneida Nations)

North Field (Duck Creek Pop Warner)

Details

- Each youth football organization is allowed 44 players and a total of six coaches/chaperones
- Wristbands will be distributed one week prior to the event
- Please drop off the signed waivers when you pick up your wristbands
- Every participant and chaperone must be wearing a wristband to gain access into the loading dock
- Everyone will be seated in the loading dock prior to the scrimmage
- Those who have tickets to the game will be escorted to the concourse following the scrimmage
- Those who do not have tickets may leave through the loading dock

Timeline

5:20 pm – Arrive at the loading dock

5:40 pm – lineup outside of the tunnel (Duck Creek followed by Oneida Nations)

5:45 pm – Walk out the tunnel and remain lined up behind the visitors bench (east wall)

5:55 pm – Scrimmage begins following the PA announcement

6:15 pm – Return back to the visitors sideline after the horn sounds

6:20 pm – Walk back to the marshalling area in the loading dock

6:30 pm – Clear out of the loading dock area

Please Remember...

- All chaperones that aren't coaches must remain on the sideline
- You are allowed to have one photographer on the field
- Coaches are allowed to stand in the backfield
- All non active players must remain on the sideline
- Designate one or two coaches as the "ball boys"
- Once the final horn sounds, it is the coaches responsibility to get the kids off the field as quick as possible
